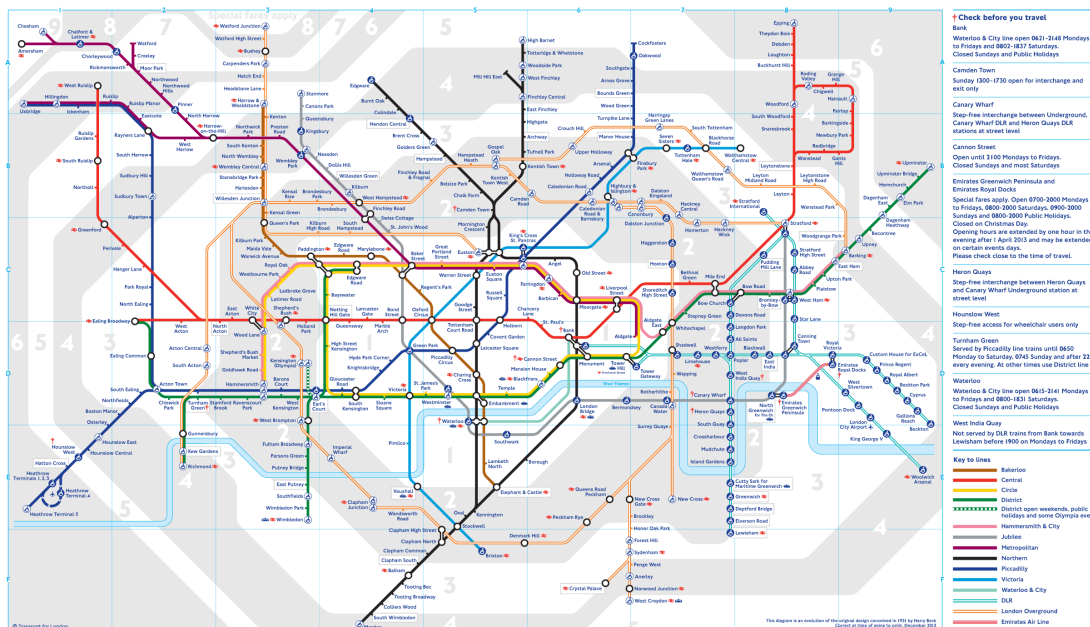

### FAMOUS TOURIST ATTRACTION

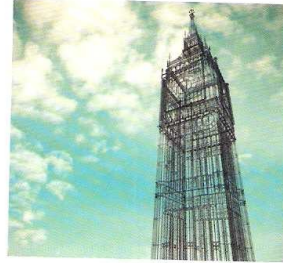
Its trademarks are Nelson's Column, which stands in the centre, the four lion statues that guard the Column, and the large number of pigeons that live in the square.

One of London's finest historic landscapes covering 142 hectares (350 acres).

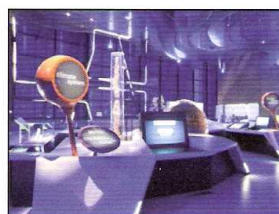
