
Its trademarks are Nelson's Column, which stands in the centre, the four lion statues that guard the Column, and the large number of pigeons that live in the square.

#### **BIG BEN**




Big Ben is the largest four-faced chiming clock and the third tallest free-standing clock tower in the world. It celebrated its 150th anniversary on 31 May 2009.
